

Professor Charles L. Miller Memorial Scholarship

1. One \$100 merit-based scholarship will be given to a returning band student. All band students that have (or will have) completed a year of band and are returning to play in MCS for the following academic year are eligible to apply. Students eligible for the scholarship must attend one of the schools in which Professor Miller taught: Gethsemane Lutheran, Holy Name, Jesuit Middle School, Sacred Heart, St. Bernard, St. James/Seton, St. Paul Lutheran, and St. Philip Neri.
2. Recipient will be chosen by MCS Governing Board and MCS Staff based on completed scholarship application.
3. Completed applications are due to the MCS office by April 1st. Please answer questions in the space provided.
4. Scholarships will be awarded each year at the Spring Joint Schools Concert as tuition credit for the following school year.
5. The recipient will have the opportunity to perform a solo at the Spring Concert, plus a presentation of the award at his or her school.
