

Nebraska Child Abuse/Neglect Law

28-711 Child subjected to abuse or neglect; report; contents; toll-free number:

- 1) When any physician, medical institution, nurse, school employee, social worker, or **other person** has **reasonable cause** to believe that a child has been subjected to abuse or neglect or observes such child being subjected to conditions or circumstances which reasonably would result in abuse or neglect, he or she shall report such incident or cause a report to be made to the proper law enforcement agency or to the department on the toll-free number established by subsection (2) of this section.
- 2) The department shall establish a statewide toll-free number to be used by any person any hour of the day or night, any day of the week, to make reports of abuse or neglect. Reports of abuse or neglect not previously made to or by a law enforcement agency shall be made immediately to such agency by the department. **1-800-652-1999**
